ALZHEIMER CALENDAR OF EVENTS:

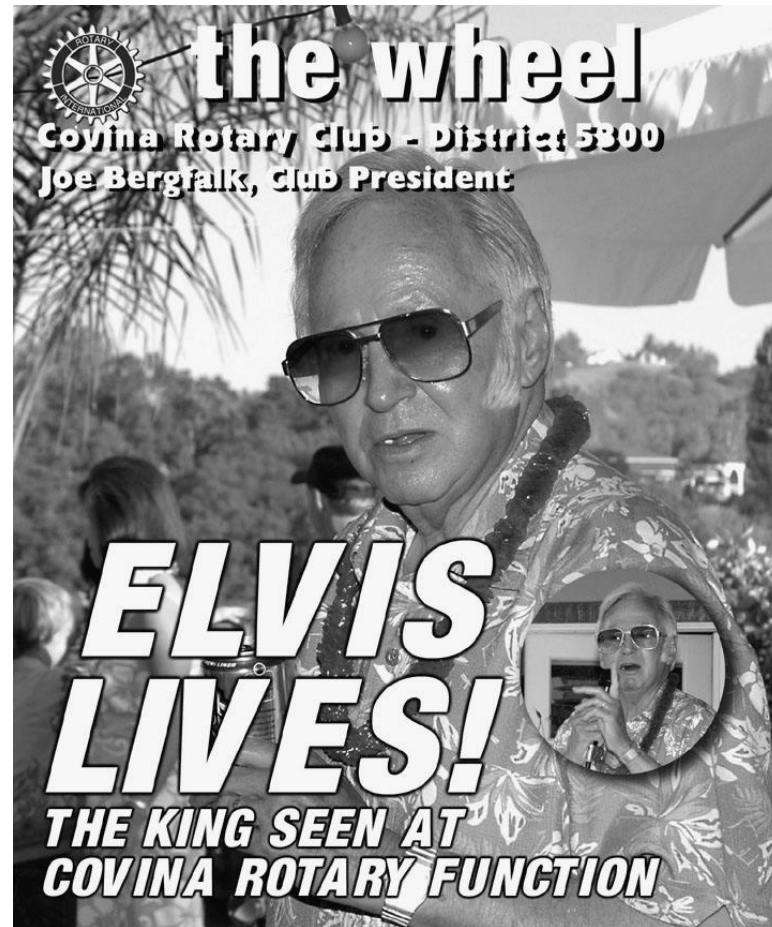
