IRRADICATE POLIO NOW!

If you could make a "difference of life or death" would you? Well you have the opportunity to make a huge difference in the life of a child.

Just a few drops of serum will allow a child to walk, not crawl, live a life of acceptance rather than rejection, allow another human being to be socially accepted in a third world country.

Your donations to The Rotary Foundation make a difference. Many of us don't remember Polio, as vaccines were routinely given to the younger generation.

Polio is a viral disease. There are three types of poliovirus and many strains of each type. The virus enters through the mouth and multiplies in the throat and gastrointestinal tract then moves into the bloodstream and is carried to the central nervous system where it replicates and destroys the motor neuron cells. Motor neurons control the muscles for swallowing, circulation, respiration and the trunk, arms and legs.
