Pomona Valley Habitat for Humanity



Jody is the President and CEO of Pomona Valley Habitat for Humanity. Last month, Pomona Valley dedicated their 43rd house in the city of Rancho Cucamonga. The Winkler family is now able to all live under one roof! Next up? The next renovation is in the city of Ontario. Habitat helps to provide decent, safe and affordable housing for low income residents in the West Inland Empire and East San Gabriel Valley. Pomona Valley is a locally run affiliate of Habitat for Humanity International, a nonprofit ecumenical Christian housing organization. They build and renovate decent and affordable housing. The homes are then sold to those in need at no profit and with no interest charged. Volunteers provide most of the labor. The mortgage payments go into a revolving fund that is used to build more houses.
