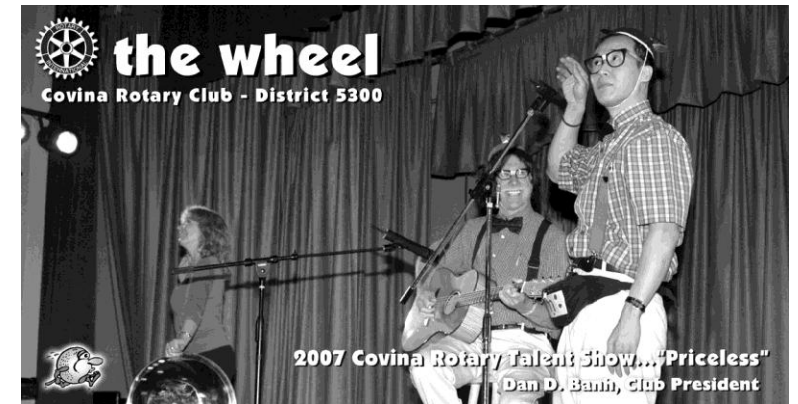
If you do any of the following things, you are performing vocational service:
