This Week: KEVIN B. KAISERMAN, MD



Kevin B. Kaiserman, MD, currently works with children and adolescents with type 1 diabetes mellitus. Prior to entering private practice, he was Clinical Associate Professor of Pediatrics and Medical Director of the Clinical Diabetes Program at both the Children's Hospital of

Los Angeles and the USC Keck School of Medicine. Dr. Kaiserman earned his medical degree from Eastern Virginia Medical School in Norfolk. He completed his internship and residency in the Department of Pediatrics and his fellowship in the Division of Pediatric Endocrinology at UCLA.

Dr. Kaiserman is a member of the American Diabetes Association and the Pediatric Endocrine Society. He is on the Los Angeles board of

directors of the American Diabetes Association as well as serving on the boards of the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation in Los Angeles and Riding On Insulin. In addition to maintaining a private practice, Dr. Kaiserman is both the camp medical director for Camp Conrad-Chinnock (a local camp for diabetic children) and a member of their board.
