



This Week: James V. Lacey, Jr., PhD



Dr. James Lacey is a cancer epidemiologist at City of Hope. He earned his M.P.H. and Ph.D. from the University of Michigan School of Public Health, in Ann Arbor. He completed a postdoctoral fellowship at the

U.S. National Cancer Institute, which is part of the National Institutes of Health, in Bethesda, Maryland. He stayed at the National Cancer Institute for another 8 years, where he led and collaborated on a wide range of epidemiologic research studies. In 2009, he joined the Department of Population Sciences at City of Hope, and earlier this year he was named the Director of the Division of Cancer Etiology. His research primarily focuses on the clinical

epidemiology of female reproductive cancers, but in recent years he has also led a significant effort to modernize and innovate the ways in which epidemiologic research is conducted. He currently leads two multi-year projects, which together are receiving over \$20 million dollars in Federal Government funding, that are adapting and applying cloud computing, mobile health, big-data, industrial-scale logistics, and customer-engagement principles to improve cancer research.

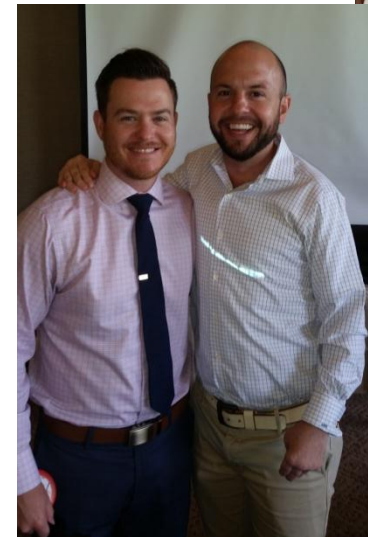
