Rotary, The Gates Foundation, and the WHO, have nearly eradicated Polio throughout the world.

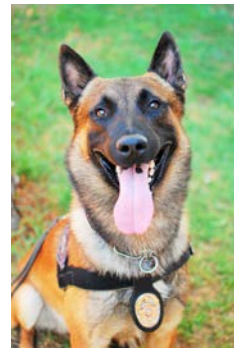
Do you have a dream? How can you make the world a better place for our communities, country and internationally? It starts with your dream... then the good work of your fellow Rotarians can make it happen.
