COVINA'S CITY MANAGER



You may be asking yourself, "Who is Brian Saeki and what does he do in our fair city?" The answer is simple. The City of Covina is governed by five city council members who are elected at large to four-year terms. Elections are held every two years (in odd numbered years) to fill

alternately two and three seats. The City Council then elects one member to serve as the Mayor for a one-year term and another as the Mayor Pro Tem. City Council meetings are held on the first and third Tuesdays of the month at 7:30 PM in the Council Chambers at City Hall, 125 E. College Street. The City Council hires a City Manager to oversee the day-to-day operations of the City and carry out the policies set by the City Council. In addition to the five-member City Council, Covina voters also elect a City Treasurer and City Clerk.
